- Kentucky State University signed the 'Recipient's Funding Certification and Agreement' for the Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act.
- 2. Funding to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students, representing 50% of Kentucky State University's total allotment under each Act of legislation was made available for distribution in the amount of \$3,477,387:
 - \$686,039 under Section 18004 (a)(1) of the CARES Act
 - \$686,039 under Section 18004 (a)(1) of the CRRSAA
 - \$2,105,309 under Section 18004 (a)(1) of the ARP
- 3. Total disbursed to students as of December 31st, 2021 is \$3,258,69680.
- 4. It is estimated that over 4,500 students are potentially eligible for CARES Act funds and eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in the Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965.
- 5. 4,140studentshavereceivedan EmergencyFinancial Aid Grant under Section18004(a)(1)of the CARES Act as of December 31, 2021.
- 6. Awarding Philosophyand Procedures:

During the first phase, all full-time Pell eligible students are able to apply for funds through the Student Financial Aid Office's website. The application will collect the following information: (1) Name, (2) KSU Student ID Number, (3) Phone Number, (4) Physical Address, (5) KSU Email Address, (6) Confirmation that students is currently enrolled and attending KSU during the current semester, (7) Demographic Information, (8) Financial Literacy Survey, and (9) Certification of Request.

All eligible students who complete the application and associated financial training will receive a predetermined allocation based upon information verified within their application.
